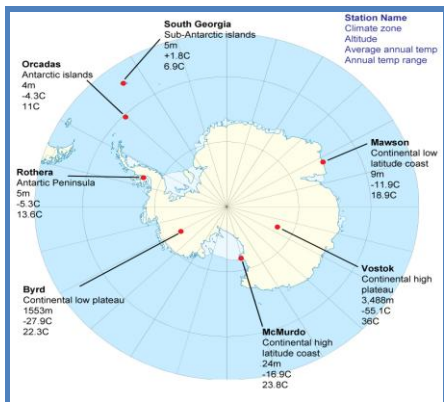


Salt Water Ice Experiment

How does the amount of ice affect the temperature of water? What impact, if any, does salt have on the temperature of ice water? For these fun science experiments, you'll need:

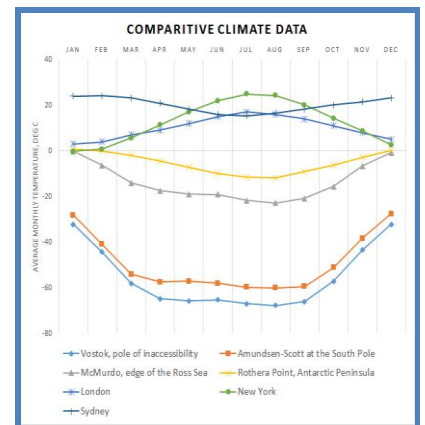
- 2 drinking glasses
