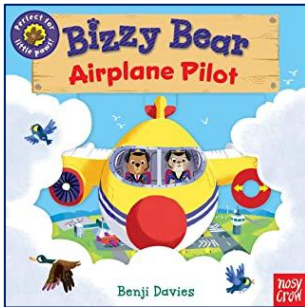

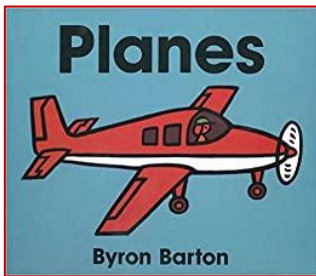
Bizzy Bear: Airplane Pilot, by Nosy Crow (Nosy Crow Publishers)

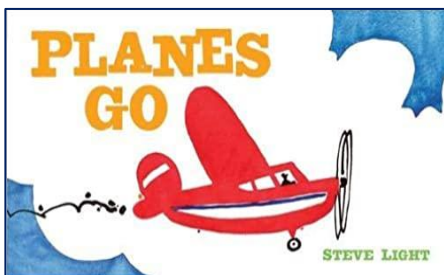
Good Night Planes, by Adam Gamble

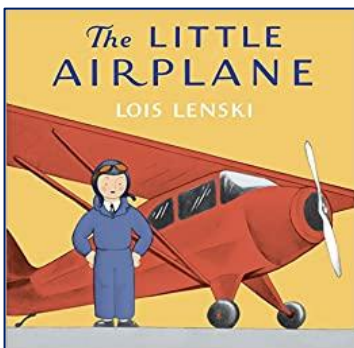
Planes, by Byron Barton
