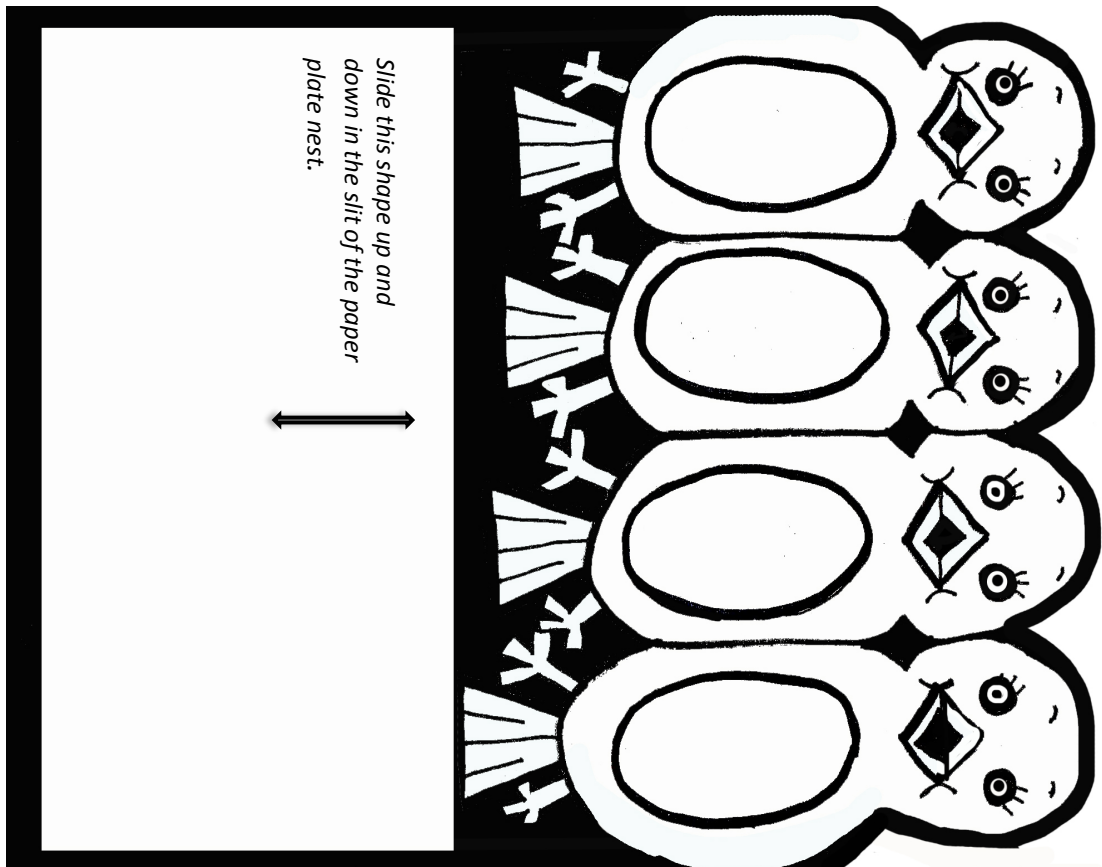
One hand holds the

## YOU WILL NEED:

- A full-sized thin white paper plate
- Scissors
- Brown paint and a brush
- Optional: twigs, leaves, grasses and glue.
- Print this page in gray scale on cardstock

## DIRECTIONS:

1. Fold the paper plate in half with the concave side in.
2. Cut a 5" slit in the folded edge of the paper plate.
3. Paint the paper plate brown. You may also glue twigs, leaves and grass to the paper plate nest for a natural look.
4. Print the chicks shape on this page onto a sheet of cardstock choosing a gray scale setting.
5. Color the baby birds, then cut out the shape.
6. Slide the chicks shape through the slit in the paper plate.
7. Have fun making the chicks pop up and down.
