


YOU WILL NEED:

- A full-sized thin white paper plate
- Scissors
- Brown paint and a brush
- Optional: twigs, leaves, grasses and glue.
- Print this page in gray scale on cardstock

DIRECTIONS:

- Fold the paper plate in half with the concave side in.
- 2. Cut a 5" slit in the folded edge of the paper plate.
- Paint the paper plate brown. You may also glue twigs, leaves and grass to the paper plate nest for a natural look.
- 4. Print the chicks shape on this page onto a sheet of cardstock choosing a gray scale setting.
- 5. Color the baby birds, then cut out the shape.
- Slide the chicks shape through the slit in the paper plate.
- 7. Have fun making the chicks pop up and down.
