

MATERIALS:


1. Five pieces of white cardstock
2. A Printer
3. Scissors
4. Colored pencils or crayons
5. A business sized envelope to keep "Shiloh" and the clothes between play sessions

DIRECTIONS:

1. Print all five pages in grayscale on cardstock.
2. Let your child color "Shiloh" and the four pages of clothing.
3. Cut out Shiloh and the clothes.
4. Cut out the "Front to Back Stand" and slit on the dotted line.
5. Slide the "Front to Back Stand" into the base stand at the dotted line on Shiloh's base.
6. Show your child how to attach the clothes to Shiloh by folding back the tabs around the shoulders and legs or head to dress for each season.




guess the season?






a knit cap. What season is it?






play in the sand. What season is it?





