Materials Needed:

A copy of this page, printed on cardstock.

Brown and pink crayons

Scissors

One paper plate cut in half

A hole punch

Yarn or string

2" strips of cardstock for a headband

A stapler with staples

Directions:

1. Print this page on cardstock.

2. Have your child color the Mother's ears and Joey's image

3. Cut out the pieces.

4. Cut a paper plate in half and staple the curved edges together to create a "Pouch".

5. Poke holes in the upper corners of the paper plate pouch and string yarn or string through the holes to tie around the child's neck.

6. Slip the Joey into the pouch.

7. Staple enough 2" cardstock strips to encircle the child's head.

8. Staple the mother kangaroo ears to the cardstock headband.

9. Let your child hop around and pretend to be a kangaroo Jill with her baby Joey.

DID YOU KNOW? Mother kangaroos are called Does, Flyers or Jills and their babies are called Joeys.
