

Doodle Lou's PAPER WHEELBARROW

Materials:

- 1 copy of wheelbarrow body printed on white yardstick (Page 2.)
- Crayons, markers, or colored pencils
- Hot glue (Adult use only)
- Four wooden craft sticks
- One empty thread spool
- A 3" piece of bamboo skewer
- Two paper clips
- Two pieces of corrugated cardboard 3" x 1"
- Utility Knife (Adult use only)

Directions:

1. Print the wheelbarrow body shape on cardstock (See page #2)
2. Color the four sides of the paper wheelbarrow. Cut it out.
3. Fold all the tabs in and glue the tabs to the side of the wheelbarrow body. (Illus. #1)
4. Glue the four wooden craft sticks to the bottom on the wheelbarrow bottom as shown (Illust # 2)
5. Run the 3" wooden skewer through the thread spool and glue the ends of the wooden skewer to the craft sticks at the surface end of the wheelbarrow body making sure the thread spool spins. (Illus #2)
6. Unfold two paper clips to create triangles (Illus #3)
7. Slit the small cardboard rectangles as shown (Illus #3) (Adult help needed.)
8. Hot glue the paper clips inside the slits in each cardboard square. (Adult help needed) (Illust #4)
9. Glue the cardboard rectangles to the opposite end of the wooden craft sticks (Illus # 5)
10. Practice wheeling your wheelbarrow around! (Illust #6)

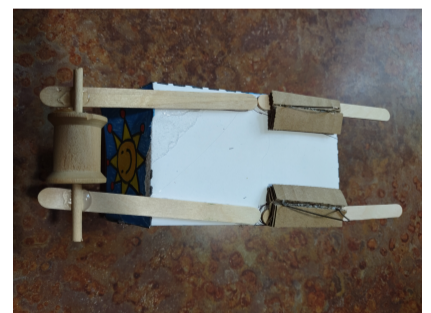

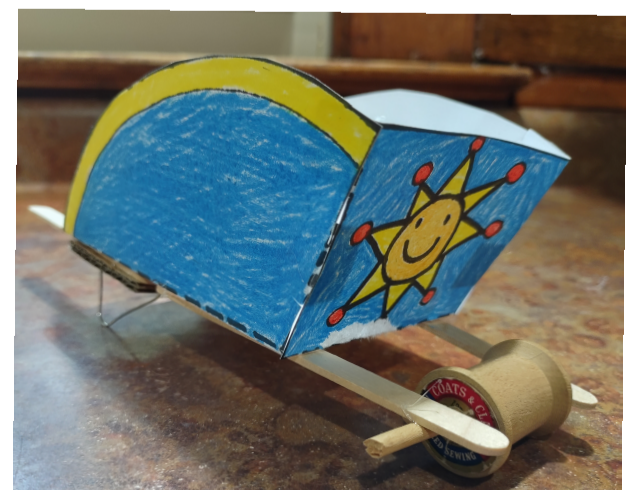
