Allow your preschool children to search the room for items such as beads, buttons, or marbles. Help them practice their counting skills by filling their egg cartons with objects.

STANDARD 1.2

A customer wants $\frac{1}{2}$ of a dozen eggs. How can I know how many should I give him?

How is this process called?
Division
How can we represent this process with math symbols?

I need to form two groups from the dozen and give one to the customer:

a)
$$2 \overline{)12} \begin{array}{r} 6 \\ -12 \\ \hline 0 \end{array}$$

b)
$$\left(\frac{1}{2}\right) \left(\frac{12}{1}\right) = \frac{1 \times 12}{2 \times 1} = \frac{12}{2} = 6$$

Introducing Fractions!

Let students explore various ways they can manipulate a dozen eggs to identify fractions as a set of 12 and to examine fraction relationships.
