


## **MATERIALS NEEDED:**


- A print out pages 1 & 2 in color on cardstock
  - Scissors
- White glue





#### **DIRECTIONS:**


- Cut out arms, legs (below) and puppet body (pg.2)
- Fold the puppet body in half vertically, so that the image is on the front. બં છં
- Glue the back of the puppet body to the front to make the body "stiffer"
- Glue the arms and legs to the back side of the body sticking out (as shown.) 4. 73. 60
  - Allow the glue to dry.
- Fold the puppet body in half with the image inside following the dark fold lines.
- Fold the top section back to show the eyes and nose.
- Flip the puppet over and fold the bottom section back to show the overalls and shirt.
- onto the top and bottom on the mouth while opening 9. Demonstrate how to work the puppet's mouth by holding and closing your fingers and thumb

















1. Cut out parts




4. Fold back at horizontal line to reveal the face




2. Fold, then glue, front to back. Glue arms & legs in place



3. Fold top of puppet forward and crease.



5. Flip and fold bottom half of puppet up.



6. Grasp at mouth sections open and close hand to make Humpty "talk".
